

Fridge Leaking Water: What to Check

Work through these before you call for repair

- 1

Unplug the fridge and locate the source
Dry the floor and watch where fresh water appears. Mind any water near electrical.
- 2

Check and clear the defrost drain
Flush the freezer-floor drain with warm water and a turkey baster.
- 3

Inspect the water supply line and shutoff
Look for cracks, kinks, or a loose fitting on the ice maker line.
- 4

Empty and reseal the drain pan
Slide it out, empty it, check for cracks, set it back level.
- 5

Level the fridge slightly back
Adjust the front feet so water drains toward the back.
- 6

Call a technician if it keeps leaking
A damaged line, failed pan, or defrost fault needs a pro.

DIY or technician, at a glance

Clogged defrost drain	DIY - flush with warm water
Overfull drain pan	DIY - empty and reseal
Fridge not level	DIY - adjust front feet
Cracked water line	Technician
Defrost system fault	Technician
